



## Frederick Allen Beck

September 8, 1940 - December 13, 2020

After a 4 year battle with renal cell carcinoma cancer, Frederick Allen Beck, age 80, passed on December 13 at home with his wife Betty holding his hand.

Fred was born in Greensburg, Pa., but moved to Daytona Beach at a very young age with his family. He attended Daytona schools and graduated from Seabreeze High School in 1958.

After a short banking career, Fred joined General Electric Company in the Financial Management Program where he finished first in his class and followed a very successful career for 28 years.

In 1988 Fred met the love of his life, Betty Reid, who also worked in the Finance Division at GE, and they were married in 1989 on Anna Marie Island. They both retired in 1994 with GE Plant Closing benefits.

During the 32 years of a very happy marriage, they managed a number of GE Volunteer projects at Camp Winona and participated in several GE Volunteer projects across the Country, snow-skied many mountains, and traveled extensively throughout the Western US, Alaska, Hawaii, Canada and Egypt. They did the rim-to-rim hike of the Grand Canyon, took an 8 day raft trip on the Colorado River through the Grand Canyon plus did multiple hikes throughout various US National Parks.

Fred is survived by his wife Betty, his daughters Dawn Beck Hansard and Terri Beck, and grandson Braden Hansard and granddaughter Jordan Whitt.

He is predeceased by his parents, Bob & Flora May Beck, sister Nancy Beck Stewart and brother Larry Beck.
